Gardener's Hand Oream

20 Drops Lavender 20 Drops Melrose 1/2 Tbsp Vitamin E 4 tbsp beeswax pellets 1/4 cup Shea Butter 1/2 cut cold-pressed, organic coconut oil.

In a double boiler (or mason jar in boiling water) melt coconut oil and shea butter together. Let cool 3-5 minutes and mix in all other ingredients.







Gardener's Hand Scrub

1/4C Brown Sugar 1/4C coconut oil 1T thieves cleaner 10 drops lemon essential oil

Mix all ingredients together and store in an airtight jar



Gardener's Hand Salve

2oz coconut oil 2oz beeswax 16oz dandelion oil (make by infusing dried dandelion flowers in olive oils for 2-4 weeks then straining out flowers) 8 drops lavender essential oil 4 drops frankincense essential oil In a double boiler (or mason jar in boiling water) melt coconut oil, beeswax, and dandelion oil together. Let cool 3-5 minutes and mix in oils.
