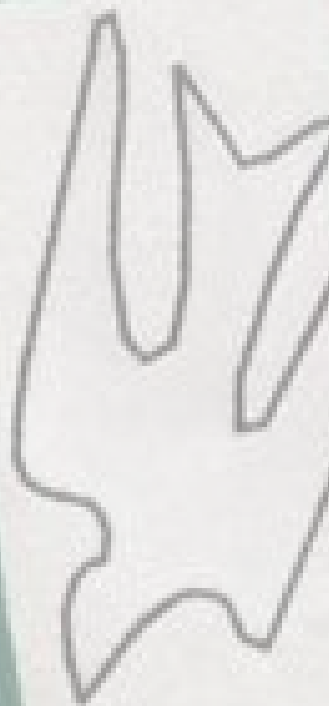

One side: 48", 50", 52", 54" or 56"

INSTRUCTIONS

Print the three pages, cut the pieces and connect them (using tape). You will need to add additional inches for the length desired. I normally will make my pulpit stoles 48", 50", 52", 54" or 56" depending on the height of the clergyperson.

*This represents one side of the stole.
