

# 4 hour 6x6 Themed Album

Welcome to my 6x6 Themed Album that you can create in 4 hours or less!

## Materials and links:

\*Graphic 45 Kraft Square Tag & Pocket Album

\*Echo Park 6x6 Paper Pad, Washi Tape, Die Cut tags, Enamel Dots and 4 - 12x12 sheets of coordinating cardstock

~Little Dreamer Boy

~Little Dreamer Girl

~Welcome Baby Boy

~Welcome Baby Girl

~My Dog

~A Magical Place

\*Adhesive (I love Cherry Tape) and foam tape or squares

\*Cutter

\*Various coordinating ribbons

## Instructions:

\*First you want to remove the 6x6 paper from pad.

\*Match the patterns together. You should have at least 24 sheets (2 pages each of 12 different patterns)

\*Choose which side of the pattern you wish to use.

\*Match an accessory to each page, then stack as in video.

# 4 hour 6x6 Themed Album - page 2

\*Choose which paper and accessory piece you want for cover. Cut the pattern paper to 5 3/4" x 5 3/4" and adhere. Apply accessory.

\*Move through the pattern pieces for interior pages, cutting them at 5 1/4" x 5 1/4", and then moving the second matching pattern paper to the bottom of the stack.

\*Sort through pictures and plan their placement, using the accessory tags and die cuts as cues.

\*Using coordinating cardstock most mats can be cut at 4" x 5", and pictures cut at 3 3/4" x 4 3/4".

\*For mats and pictures on tags, cut mat at 4 1/4" x 4", and pictures at 4" x 3 3/4". ( used a corner rounder to follow the lines on the tags) Cut 6 pieces of coordinating ribbon at 8" long to put through grommet at top of tag.

\*Finish accessorizing with enamel dots and remaining tags.

\*You can add more tags or letters to the remaining inside pockets.

\*\*Please note that when you see the pictures below, that I did not start on the inside cover; however, you certainly could add something there.
