Recipe of the Month

Curry Chicken Stir Fry Salad

1 c thinly sliced chicken * 2 tbsp slivered ginger * 4 cloves minced garlic * 1/4 tsp Herbamere * 2 d YL ginger oil * Cook/brown the chicken, add ginger, garlic & herbamere, toss over medium heat for approx 2-3 minutes. Remove from heat, set aside.

Combine in pan, over low heat 1 can organic coconut milk * 2 tsp organic yellow curry powder * 1/4 tsp herbamere. Pour over chicken. Let sit, keep hot.

Combine in a serving bowl *2 thinly sliced carrots * 1 c finely chopped broccoli * 1 c sliced celery * 1/2 c finely chopped cilantro * Put 2 d YL Lemongrass & Black Pepper essential oil on a stainless steel serving spoon. Rub it evenly on spoon with finger. Toss vegetables well. Pour chicken sauce over vegetables and enjoy. Hearty serving for 2.

Health Tip of the Month

Why do we care about diffusing essential oils? Outside Air Hazards

- EPA admits that breathing outdoor toxic chemicals can expose Americans to a lifetime cancer risk that is 10 times greater than the level considered acceptable.
- •It is known that the levels of toxic chemical exposures indoors are 5 to 10 times greater.
- Federal studies have shown that most samples of indoor air have high concentrations of toxic pesticides
- -Diazon and DDT (banned over 30 yrs. Ago) were present in 90% of indoor air samples.
- -Toxic chlorpyrifos (Dursban) found in 70%
- -2,4-D found in almost 60%
- -Trifluralin found in almost 50%

Indoor Air Hazards

- Solvents such as benzene, xylene, toluene and styrene can lower testosterone and sperm levels, contribute to abortions, birth defects, asthma, nose congestion and adversely affect the blood and heart.
- •Formaldehyde in carpets and construction materials are often unrecognized causes of environment illness.

- Leukemia is several times more likely to children if pesticides are used in and around the homes.
- Chemicals released from hot Teflon pots, microwaved foods and aerosols containing disinfectants, deodorizers, oven cleaners, foods and cooking odors, hair or ironing sprays, etc. all contribute to indoor air pollution.
- Studies indicate that children and pregnant women are particularly sensitive to chemicals.
- •In California, 87% of school districts use toxic pesticides.
- •70% used suspected cancer-causing chemicals
- •54% used substances that harm the nervous system
- •52% used chemicals that cause birth defects and prevent normal physical and mental development
- •50% used chemicals that disrupt hormones **Modern Testing: Thieves**
